- Social skills: Children can learn to communicate with teachers and new friends
- Independence: Children can learn to be responsible for tidying up their bricks
- STEM concepts: Children can learn about the basics of friction and torque, or about space exploration and movie-making
- Coding: Children can learn the basics of coding
- Engineering principles: Children can learn about engineering principles
- Storytelling: Children can learn about storytelling
